



Transfer Application Checklist

- ☐ Application - Electronic application submitted through LSAC
- ☐ Letter of Intent
- ☐ Resume - No more than one page with conventional formatting and font size
- ☐ All applicants must complete the Honor Code Commitment and Ecclesiastical Endorsement
 - Both Latter-day Saint and non-Latter-day Saint applicants agree to abide by the Honor Code and related policies.
 - If you have a current (unexpired) Honor Code Commitment and Ecclesiastical Endorsement at the time of submitting your completed application, you will not need to complete new ones. However, if this will be your first Ecclesiastical Endorsement or if your Ecclesiastical Endorsement has expired and you are a Latter-day Saint applicant, you must obtain one from:
 - Your current Bishop; AND
 - A current member of your stake presidency
 - Non-Latter-day Saint applicants need an endorsement from a member of clergy from their own faith (or a local latter-day Saint Bishop) and from the non-denominational BYU chaplain.
- ☐ Letter of recommendation from a law professor
- ☐ Letter of good standing from current law school
- ☐ Applicant's current law school class ranking
